

Community Forum Usage Guidelines

Welcome to Sage Software Accountants Network Community Forum! This Forum provides members with an opportunity to connect with colleagues to exchange ideas, ask questions, and share information.

This Forum is here for the enjoyment and benefit of Sage Software Accountants Network members. Like any community, these types of forums are most valuable when everyone obeys certain basic guidelines and rules for online behavior. These guidelines and rules are presented here so that you know what is expected of you and what you can expect from other participants when using the forum. By registering, you agree to follow these Usage Guidelines.

1. Keep it relevant.

For everyone's benefit, please stay on topic. 3. Keep it spam-free.

4. Keep it legal.
